Your Club Name **Codes of Conduct / Responsibilities for Parents / Guardians / Spectators**

Parents / Guardians / Spectators are expected to:

- Complete and return the Registration / Consent Form pertaining to their child's participation
- Deliver and collect their child to and from coaching sessions / matches punctually
- Ensure their child is properly and adequately clothed for the weather conditions
- Ensure that proper footwear and protective equipment are worn at ALL times. Any child not in possession of the fundamental requirements will not be permitted to participate
- Detail any health concerns relating to the child on the consent form, in particular breathing or chest conditions. Any changes to the state of the child's health should be reported to the coach prior to coaching sessions
- Inform co-ordinator if their child has been ill or hurt recently
- Inform the coach prior to departure from the field of play if their child is to be collected early from a coaching session
- Encourage their child to play by the rules and teach them that they can only do their best
- Show appreciation and support the coach
- Be realistic
- Ensure their child's hygiene and nutritional needs are met
- Accept the referee / game supervisor's judgement
- Promote their child's participation in playing football for fun
- Behave responsibly on the sidelines
- Encourage child to show respect

Parents / guardians have the right to:

- Know their child is safe
- Be informed of problems or concerns relating to their children
- Be informed if their child is injured
- Contribute to decisions within the centre
- Speak to the Co-ordinator and voice their concerns about the standards of coaching

Any misdemeanors and breach of this code of conduct will be dealt with immediately by the Co-ordinator. Persistent concerns or breaches will result in the parent or guardian being asked not to attend the centre if their attendance is detrimental to the child's welfare. Should a parent / guardian continue to breach the code of behaviour, the Co-ordinator may regrettably ask the child to leave the centre.
